- I. Timber Harvest Plan-Costs depend on acreage/complexity of issues-typical range of \$5-\$35k
- II. 1600 Permit- Streambed Alteration Permit thru Dept of Fish and Game
 - a. Timber Harvest Plan\$1345.25 base fee + \$112 for each project
 - b. Master Agreement for THP\$8404.75 base fee + \$112 for each project + \$1120.50 annual fee
 - c. Routine Maintenance Agreement \$1345.25 + \$112 for each project (5 years or less)
 - i. \$2689.50 + \$112 for each project (longer than 5 years)
 - d. Minor amendments \$168
 - e. Major amendments \$560.25
 - f. There are additional fees for larger projects....
- III. Dept. of Fish and Game THP Review Filing Fee- \$949.50 going up 1-1-11 to \$965.50
 - a. Due within 30 days of approval of plan

 - a. Currently its 3 calls per station for two years, next year six call per year for two years. Approx \$30-\$35/station/per visit-depends on location of project, accessibility, etc.
- VI. Waiver of Waste Discharge (Erosion Control Plan)- \$1200 minimum per year enrolled-need to enroll each year THP is open regardless if there's operations or not
- VII. Natural Diversity Database -\$600 per subscription with \$400/yr renewal if renewal in 6 mo-

 - a. Records Check \$150/hr and \$225 for priority check thru Northeast Information Center
