Forest Practice Rules

(currently more than 1,000 planning, operational and monitoring rules)

- public involvement
- agency promulgation
- Board of Forestry oversight

Implementation

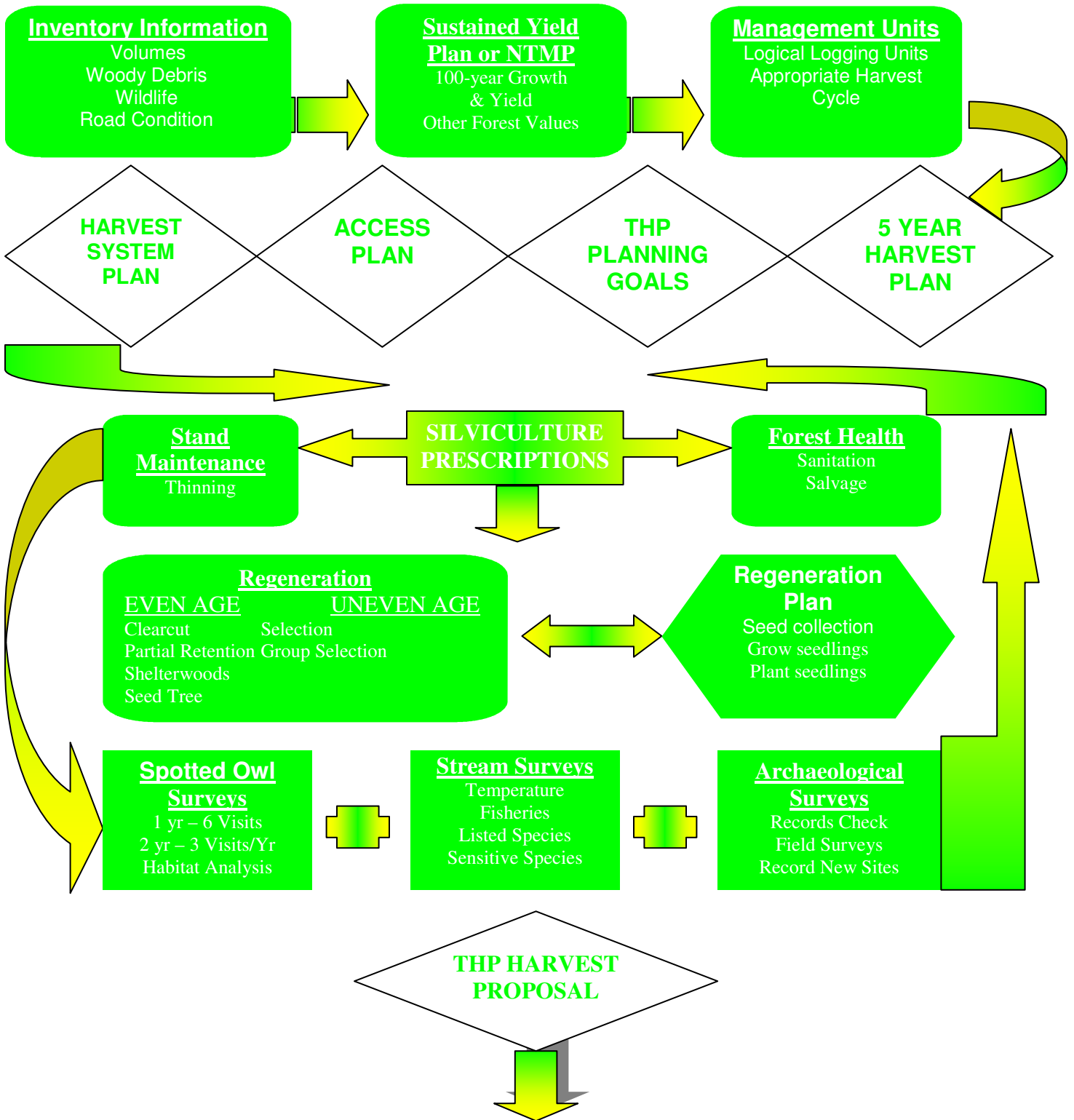
- site-specific mitigation (PHIs)
- implementation by licensed logging professionals (LTOs)
- CDF inspection for plan compliance
- significant administrative, civil and criminal penalties for non-compliance
- post-harvest monitoring and tree planting

Environmental Analysis and Planning

- site specific discretionary environmental permits (THPs)
- landscape plans (SYPs, PTEIRs, NTMPs, HCPs)
- developed by licensed forestry professionals (RPFs)
- interdisciplinary review by agencies
- public input

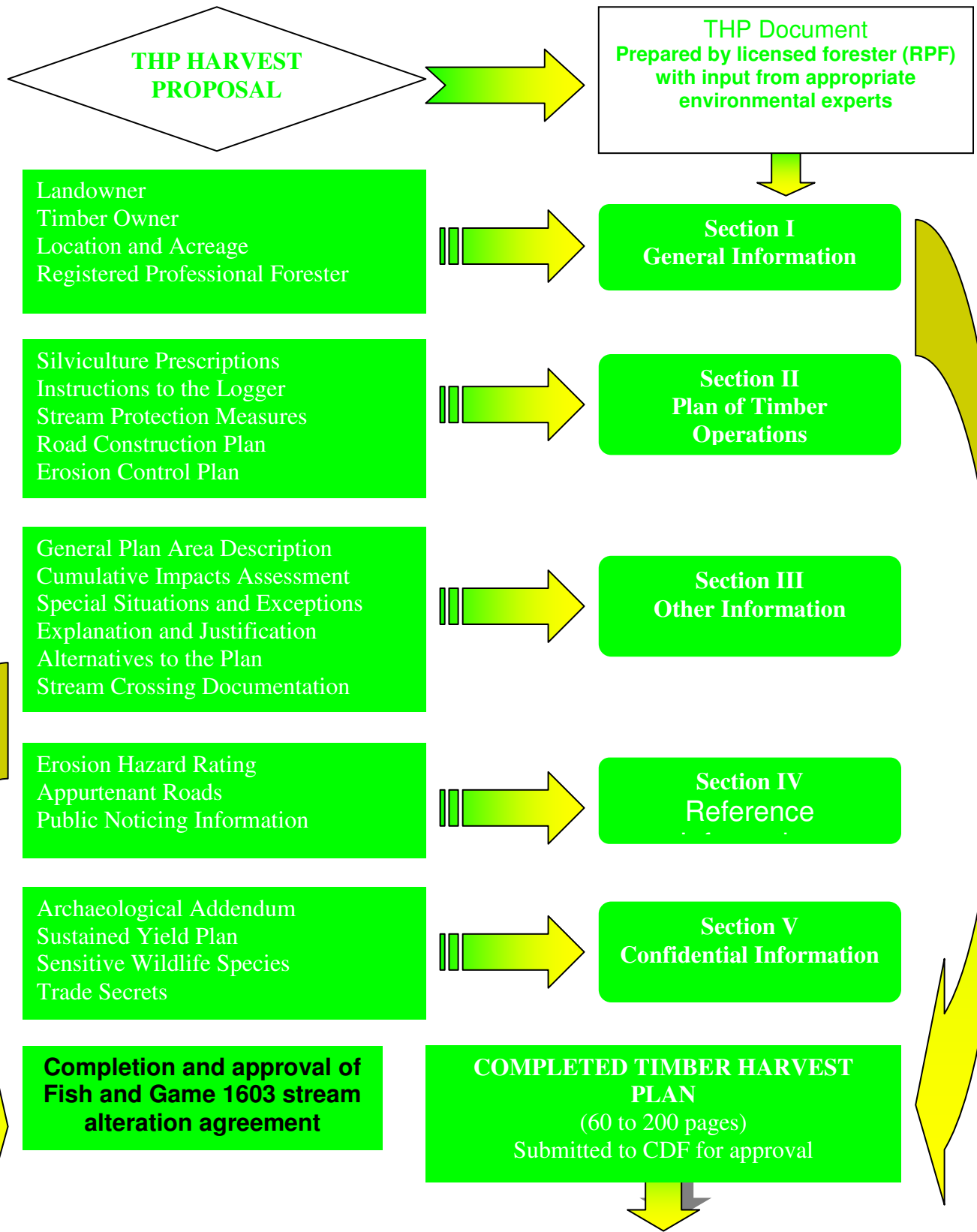

Year One and Two



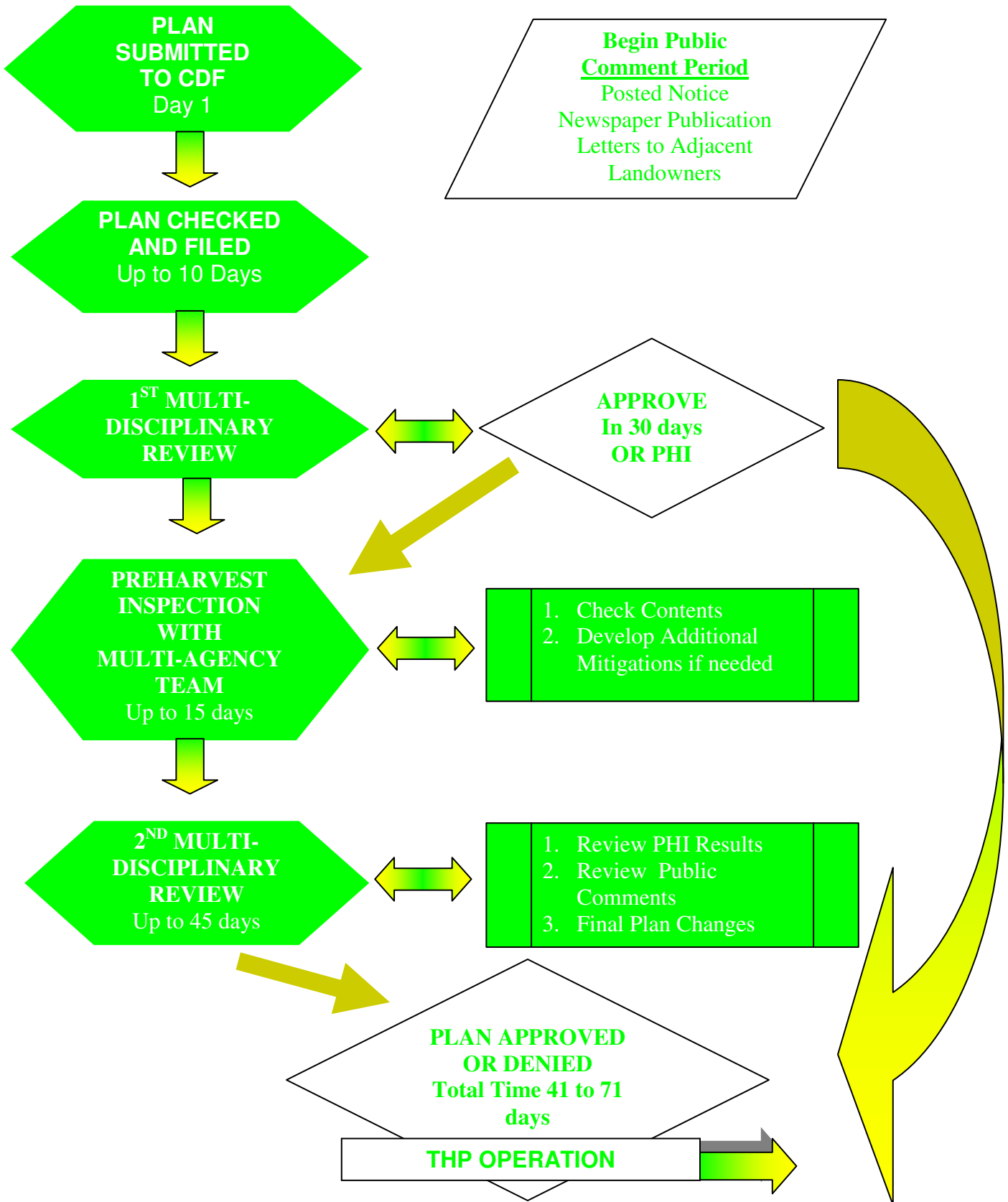
